Message Stick In Aboriginal Culture, Message Sticks were used to relay messages to people of other tribes and to provide Right of Passage to the Messenger.

Custodian Deaneries/Parishes/Schools/Religious Congregations/Groups become 'Guardians' of the Message Stick and are responsible for its safe-keeping.

Messenger Means person who picks up the Message Stick from previous Parish, eg. At last Mass, or from previous booking, and carries it to their Deanery/Parish/School/Congregation/Group.
